JOB PURPOSE

The Math and/or Literacy Interventionist will assist in delivering intervention services to students who have been identified as struggling learners in math and/or literacy so as to enable them to meet their academic grade level goals. Working with classroom teachers and other professional support staff, the Math and/or Literacy Interventionist will assist in implementing identified strategies for students identified as needing additional support in math and/or literacy. The Math and/or Literacy Interventionist will be responsible for keeping records to effectively progress monitor the work efforts of the identified students receiving services.

ESSENTIAL DUTES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Assists in providing targeted intervention to small groups of identified struggling learners.
- 2. Participates in the identification of eligible students for math and/or literacy intervention services
- 3. Able to use appropriate instructional strategies and materials provided by specialists and/or administration to meet the individual needs of each student
- 4. Able to utilize diagnostic tools for assessment of identified students provided by specialists and/or administration
- 5. Implements plans for students in collaboration with classroom teachers and/or other professional staff specialists
- 6. Keeps appropriate records (i.e., progress monitoring) and prepares individual student reports related to targeted interventions
- 7. Communicates with classroom teachers and other professional staff regarding student needs and progress
